**Terms and conditions**

- 1) SCALA GROUP SPA, hereon referred as SCALA, licenses for reproduction, images from its own archives or made available by third parties. The images can be supplied on film or in electronic form, depending on the agreements between the parties. SCALA will respect the confidentiality of client's projects in progress.
- 2) The images can be supplied on approval and/or for licensing with the obligation to return them within 3 months from receipt. The client is obliged, after making the sole agreed use of them, to return them within and not after the said period, carriage paid to SCALA offices. Shipment are at the client's risk.
- 3) The licensee is, in any case, responsible for keeping the images in perfect condition: whenever the transparencies, prove in the unquestionable view of SCALA, to have been damaged in any way, the licensee will be required to pay a minimum amount corresponding to the tariff of a single use in one language. In the case of no restitution, the client will be required to pay damages in a minimum amount corresponding to twice the tariff of a single world use of the image. The payment of an indemnity does not imply any right to the damaged or unreturned images on the part of the client. In the case of a simple delay in restitutio SCALA will issue, without further notice, additional invoices for one third the amount already billed or, in the on-approval case, invoices for one third the amount billable for the agreed use for any additional three months period of delay.
- 4) The client will under no circumstances be allowed to reproduce the images without first specifying in writing the use to which the reproductions will be put and receiving written authorization from SCALA. The SCALA invoice including the images is substitutive of the written authorization.
- 5) The assignment of rights of reproduction and publication is not exclusive and SCALA has a full and perfect right to assign the same rights to third parties. No right can be considered assigned before the agreed fee is paid to SCALA and to possible different copyright Proprietors. Any reproduction fees requested by the Proprietor of the works of art are at the client's charge.
- 6) SCALA has a full and perfect right to take photographs for third parties of subjects that have previously been photographed on commission of a different client.
- 7) Under no circumstances may the client without prior written consent from SCALA, loan, lease, sell, publish, circulate on line sublease or transfer in any way or support suitable for reproduction, the images in their possession, not even for joint publications or at no charge if this condition is not met, the contract will be considered void ipso jure, and the client will be subject to the payment of damages.
- 8) Under no circumstances may the client duplicate the transparencies or files at a resolution higher than 640x480 pixel and 72 dip, or make prints from them, without prior written consent from SCALA, under penalty of immediate cancellation of the contract, and subject to the payment of damages.
- 9) The client, in compliance with current legislation, will indicate the source of each photograph by the credit line: «©Photo SCALA, Florence» followed by the name of other copyright holders and by the year, either appearing next to each reproduction or at the beginning or end of the work in which the images are published in this case identifying them one by one.
- 10) The client undertakes to deliver to SCALA upon first publication, free of charge, one complimentary copy of the publication or product created.
- 11) SCALA assumes no responsibility on the captions to the works photographed or about images possibly reproduced the wrong way round.
- 12) SCALA is not answerable nor can under any circumstances be considered responsible for any infringement of the regulations laid down by the Civil Code and Special Laws covering image or copyright protection deriving from publication of the images supplied by SCALA. SCALA will point out, without assuming for this any responsibility, any limitations or obligations placed on the use of images by bodies (galleries, museums, libraries, private collections, etc) or private individuals holding copyright on the works photographed.
